INTRODUCTION The North Mariana Islands are located about 1,250 miles from the Philippines, 690 miles west of Guam, 1,400 miles from Japan and 1,430 miles east of Hawaii. These Islands of the Philippine archipelago share a common history and culture with its neighbors. The establishment of the Commonwealth of the North Mariana Islands was originally envisioned as a gesture of friendship and goodwill between the people of the Philippines and the residents of the western Pacific. Through the passage of several decades, however, the Crowns of the North Marianas have observed that, at least to some extent, they have become the host of the

people of the Philippines. The status quo remains that the country is governed as a semiautonomous territory of the Republic of the Philippines and the resident government in Saipan and Tinian is responsible for its internal affairs. While the Government of the United States administers the supreme law of the land in the Commonwealth of the North Marianas, the people are governed by laws framed by the residents of the islands. While the people of the islands enjoy a high degree of social stability, they have the feeling of uncertainty about the future of their island. The people of the North Marianas, particularly the commonwealth citizens, do not feel fully committed to the people of the Philippines, whose homeland they share.
