I have a Lenovo X1 Carbon, with a built in 1440p display. The video outputs on my laptop are 1680x1050 and I have an HDMI monitor connected. The physical size of both of those displays are the same. I also have a second 1080p monitor connected to my laptop, which I normally use. When I turn on the laptop with the second monitor connected, unity automatically tries to open a window titled ExternalDisplay-340. Both monitors are listed as being at the correct size and position when I open the system settings. Is there a way to get unity to work properly with both monitors? A: What do you mean by "automatic opening"? The problem is probably that Unity tries to position the maximized Window (which you are already looking at) on the "340" monitor (I don't know if it does that). I don't think there is a way to tell Unity not to do that. I had the same problem with the touch screen on a touchscreen laptop. (You can see the screens on touchscreens separately (e.g. "finger swipe").) This is what I did to get it to work: I started the ExternalDisplay window I chose "Configure second screen" from the top menu Then I chose "Second screen" in the left menu and then "Lock to panel" I added my regular main monitor to the "Panel" and then "Second screen" and then "Maximized" and then "Adjust to screen" (or something like that) and then "Lock to panel" (note that in order to make the change take effect, I had to restart X) I went back to Unity That worked. Now Unity won't try to position my maximized window on the 340 screen. A: I have solved the problem by removing the hdmi cable and plugging it back
